Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge is situated in North Western Rwanda in the foothills of the mighty Virungas, the chain of 15,000 ft volcanoes stretching through Rwanda, Uganda & the Democratic Republic of Congo.

The lodge is only minutes away from the headquarters of the Parc National des Volcans from where clients trek on foot to see the magnificent Mountain Gorilla – perhaps one of the most dramatic, thrilling and poignant wildlife experiences possible.

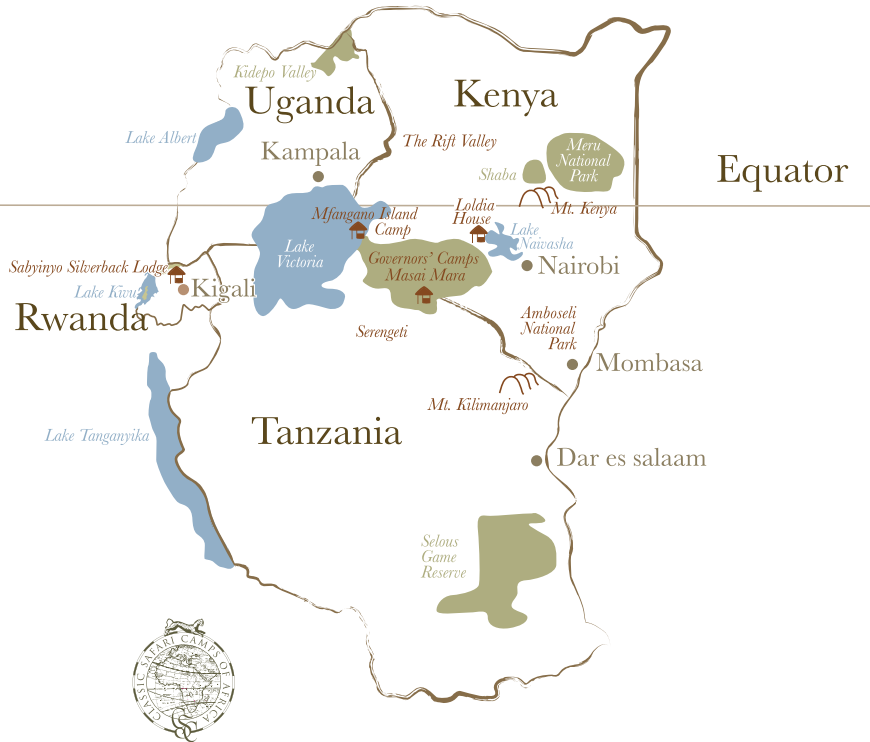

The lodge is built and operated by Governors' Camp. The lodge is owned by a Community Trust, SACOLA, which uses rentals and community fees from the lodge to drive socio-economic development and conservation initiatives in the communities adjacent to the National Park. - On the edge of the Parc National des Volcans with sweeping views of the surrounding volcanoes and lowland farms
- 10 minutes from the Park Headquarters where clients start their Gorilla Trek
- 5 cottages, 2 suites, 1 family suite. All with fireplaces, dressing rooms and stylish en-suite bathrooms with a Venetian plaster finish
- Main lodge building comprises reception, library, large sitting room and large dining room, with baronial fireplaces. Patios allow al-fresco dining and sundowners

- Gorilla trekking
- Trek to see the rare Golden Monkey, mysterious rainforest and unique bird-life
- Visit the Musanze lava flows and the Lakes Burera, Ruhondo and Karago, or the majestic Lake Kivu
- Explore Ruhengeri, a bustling Rwandese market town
- Visit the socio-economic and conservation projects run by SACOLA, the community trust that owns the lodge, and by African Wildlife Foundation and its local partner, the International Gorilla Conservation Program and learn about the exceptional work being done by these organizations

GETTING THERE:

- Rwandair Express and Kenya Airways fly daily between Kigali and Nairobi. Flying time 1 hour and 15 minutes
