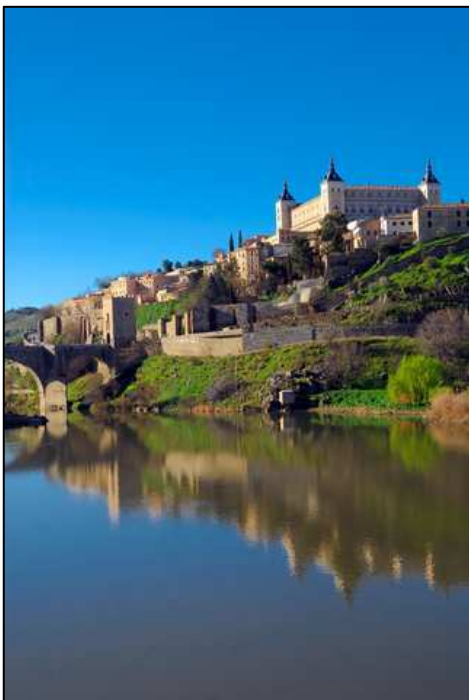

Toledo is known as the "city of the three cultures", because Christians, Arabs and Jews lived together there for centuries. It is one of the Spanish cities with the greatest wealth of monuments: the medieval quarter with the gothic cathedral, the old Jewish quarter with medieval synagogues, palaces, fortresses, mosques,... You will feel to be in another era, stroll through its medieval streets.



Segovia, the old quarter of which, along with its Roman aqueduct, are World Heritage Sites, lies on high ground between the Eresma and Clamores Rivers. In addition to its famous aqueduct, numerous Romanesque churches, the Cathedral and Fortress go to form this magnificent landscape that presides over this part of Castile.

In Madrid, we recommend a private visit to Prado museum. You will visit one of the most impressive art collections in the world, accompanied by an art and history expert who will show you the most important details of the great masters.

We suggest to lodge at one luxurious five star hotel, located in the cultural and business district, the hotel is just minutes from the Prado Museum, Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, ...
