# Private Polynesia...

Sailing from one island to another, the ROA yacht and its crew follow guests' desires. Discovering TAHITI'S most beautiful islands according to any itinerary and schedule:

**BORA BORA** - the Romantic Island,

**TAHAA** - the Vanilla Island,

**RAIATEA** - the Sacred Island,

**HUAHINE** - the garden of Eden.

ROA YACHTING offers one price for a unique discovery, which includes everything needed to make a journey an unforgettable and unique experience: on-board meals and an attentive crew, as well as recreational activities such as a tour of a pearl cultivation farm and a vanilla plantation, snorkelling or diving with sharks, a botanical safari in an all-terrain vehicle ... etc.

The yacht, entirely renovated in 2007 and fully air-conditioned, sleeps a maximum of 8 guests in its 4 cabins: 2 cabins each with a king size bed and 2 cabins each with 2 single beds. It provides the ultimate in luxury comfort and gracious living with its spacious 30m 'living room'.

The **square** of the yacht, known as the «living room», is entirely fitted with cherry wood panelling and furnished with leather sofas. It opens onto the aft deck with a huge picture window. It also boasts a home cinema entertainment system and a bar. Meals can be served in the adjoining dining room.

The **aft deck** boasts a large table in solid teak with comfortable chairs to enjoy lunch or an evening cocktail while observing the stingrays attracted by the underwater lighting system.

Each **cabin** has air-conditioning and a hi-fi CD/MP3 player.

The large **rear deck** in teak makes swimming in crystal clear lagoon waters a reality. It is equipped with a bathing ladder and a shower with both hot and cold water.

The **flybridge** (the upper deck) hosts a cockpit as well as a solarium with teak sofas, settees, awning sun protection and a music system.

The yacht's professional crew, consisting of a captain, a steward and a chef, is on board 24 hours a day. Each crew member speaks several languages including: French, English, German, Italian and Spanish.

The yacht is certified by the British commercial MCA, the highest in safety standards, which includes annual inspections, latest generation equipment and a qualified crew. Its professional charter navigation license number is n° RC 07187 B – Tahiti 82 6461.

## Design features of the Yacht:

Equipped with two GM 870cv engines, it cruises at a speed of 20 knots, autonomously for 500 miles. It boasts the latest generation in navigation and communication equipment (Radar, GPS, depth sounders, chartplotter) to ensure total safety.

## Rear cabin

Burgundy tones & cherry wood.

King size bed (2 m wide).

1 private bathroom (wash basin, bidet, wc / shower separated). Private staircase.

Cabin size: 15m<sup>2</sup>

## Front cabin

Beige tones & cherry wood.

King size bed (1.80 m wide).

2 private bathrooms (wash basin, shower / wash basin, bidet, wc). Cabin size: 14m<sup>2</sup>

## 'Twin' cabins

Each one has two single beds

(0.90 m wide) and a private bathroom (wash basin, bidet, wc / shower separated).

Cabin size: 8m<sup>2</sup>



# Four to seven day private luxury cruise in the 'Iles Sous Le Vent'

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The length of this cruise gives you the opportunity to discover the «ILES SOUS LE VENT» in more depth, thanks to a dream itinerary along the BORA BORA, TAHAA, RAIATEA and HUAHINE islands, a journey of 150 nautical miles (280 km). ROA YACHTING suggests the following 7-day programme, but you can tailor the itinerary according to your needs and wishes. The crew can recommend the best spots and activities, according to your preferences.

## Day 1 - Embark in BORA BORA

After being greeted at the airport, you will be transferred aboard the ROA motor yacht, where you will be served a welcome cocktail. Once settled into your luxury cabin, you will be able to take a dip in the lagoon's clear-blue waters. Then, the yacht will head to TAHAA.

## Day 2 – TAHAA, the Vanilla Island

On this luxurious, untamed island, spend the morning discovering the black pearl cultivation, and the secrets of vanilla plantations. Then, explore the emerald-green waters of the lagoon by snorkelling, or in a clear-bottomed kayak, and observe the many exotic fish, rays and coral gardens. At dusk, your yacht will sail towards the RAIATEA Island.

## Day 3 - RAIATEA, the Sacred Island

Explore this island and its magnificent mountains by 4x4. First, discover the famous Faaroa crater, followed by a visit to the «marae royal de Taputapuetea» to immerse yourself in the Polynesian culture. Along the way, you will enjoy an introduction to tropical fauna, notably the famous and emblematic «Tiaré» flower. Then spend the afternoon in idleness, swimming and strolling on the beaches.

## Day 4 - RAIATEA, the Magical Nature

Your yacht will anchor in the Faaroa bay, which will be the starting point of a canoe trip along the Faaroa River. Experience the unique atmosphere of lush vegetation, with its touch of paradise and spend the afternoon shopping and swimming before heading to HUAHINE Island.

## Day 5 - HUAHINE, The Garden of Eden

On a jet ski safely explore the lagoons, where you may catch a glimpse of dolphins. Then, meander in the Fare village and visit the typical seafront market with its many crafts shops. The yacht will leave in the afternoon, heading to BORA BORA.

## Day 6 - BORA BORA, the Romantic Island

The island has one of the most beautiful lagoons in the world and is a true jewel. Scuba dive with sharks or explore the underwater marvels in the morning and then relax with a picnic on a desert motu, fish or swim in the afternoon. At the end of the day enjoy the sunset.

## Day 7 - BORA BORA, a Scent of Eternity

On the last day, after a breakfast with a view of the sea start with a walk to visit the numerous art galleries. Then, enjoy a last dip in the magnificent lagoon in the early afternoon, before the crew bids you farewell.





# About Tahiti...

French Polynesia, often called 'TAHITI' is situated in the South Pacific and is composed of 5 archipelagoes, the most famous of which are the 'Iles De La Société' (Society Islands) and the 'Iles Marquises' (Marquisas Islands). As vast as Europe, these island chains are composed of volcanic islands and coral atolls.

Tahiti offers a unique blend of authenticity and exotic flavours with its breathtaking landscapes, crystal-clear blue lagoons, diverse tropical wildlife and the legendary hospitality of the Tahitians.

Far-removed from the fast-paced modern world, enjoy one of the last paradises on Earth, observe the exceptional marine wildlife, appreciate the mild climate and savour Polynesian cuisine.

ROA YACHTING offers cruises from the Island of BORA BORA, the pearl of the Pacific, renowned for its lagoon, one of the most beautiful in the world. The island is a 45-minute flight away from PAPEETE, the Polynesian capital, and host to the International Airport.

## Weather:

French Polynesia has a pleasant tropical climate cooled by the South-Pacific winds. The average temperature varies only between 78° and 86° Fahrenheit. The driest and «coolest» season is March through to mid-November («coolest» means that the minimum temperature rarely falls below 75°F). From mid-November through to February, the weather is warm and humid with frequent rainfalls in January and February. However, the storms seldom last more than 20 to 30 minutes. Each anchorage is in a lagoon: consequently, the sea is very calm during the night and safe. There is no hurricane risk in this zone.

## Cruise rates ROA Motor Yacht

<b>Number of passengers:</b>	4 to 8 people in 4 cabins (2 double cabins and 2 twin cabins).
<b>Itineraries and schedule:</b>	Guest choice can refer to the suggested itineraries in the cruise descriptions.
<b>Departure / arrival:</b>	The dates of boarding and landing are up to the Client. There are no imposed timeframes such as «boarding on Monday, landing on Thursday or Sunday». Upon landing, the Guests are accompanied to their hotel or to the Bora Bora airport.
<b>On-board meals:</b>	Included. Beverages other than mineral water and fruit juices are not included.
<b>Activities included:</b>	You may choose one activity per day of the cruise: for example, a botanical safari in an all-terrain vehicle, water-skiing, a tour of a vanilla plantation, a trip up the Faarao river, a dive with sharks, a breakfast by the sea, a tour of a pearl cultivation farm, jet-skiing...
<b>Free activities:</b>	Snorkelling, use of the rowing-boat and of the clear-bottomed kayak, fishing
